Precautions prior to the conference

1. Vaccination

- Email proof of up to date COVID-19 vaccination and booster to CMDA at PALTC2022@gmail.com
- Individuals unable to show proof of up to date COVID vaccination per the [CDC Definition](#) before April 28, 2022 should attend the conference virtually

2. Self-test

- Consider performing a COVID-19 self-test prior to the conference, per [CDC recommendations April 18, 2022](#)
- If you have a positive COVID test: Please attend the conference virtually.

3. Screen

- Check for COVID-19 symptoms or use the [CDC Coronavirus Self-Checker](#)
- If you have symptoms: Please attend the conference virtually.

Precautions during the conference

1. Individuals unable to show proof of up to date COVID vaccination prior to the conference, have a positive COVID test or have COVID-19 symptoms should attend the conference virtually.
2. Wear a well-fitting, medical grade mask when not actively eating or drinking
